

ARTICLE 10

LEGAL HOLIDAYS

The following holidays are scheduled with pay for all classified employees working on a calendar month basis. In order to receive compensation for the holidays below, the employee must be in a paid status on the District workday before or the District workday after the holiday listed.

The District will provide a list of paid holidays to employees, based on their work year, prior to August 31.

Washington's Birthday	February 15, 2021
Memorial Day	May 31, 2021

Everyday appointed by the President, and the Governor of this State, as provided for in Subdivisions (b) and (c) of E.C. Section 37220 for public fast, Thanksgiving or holiday, or any day declared a holiday under E.C. Section 1318 or 37222 for classified employees.

Employees in the bargaining unit, who are not normally assigned to duty during the school holidays of the winter recess period, shall be paid for those holidays provided that they were in a paid status during any portion of the working day of their normal assignment immediately preceding or succeeding the holiday period.

When a legal holiday falls on Sunday, the following day is declared a holiday, except the Monday following Easter Sunday.

When a legal holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday is declared a holiday.

Any other holidays approved by the Board of Trustees may be added to the above list.
